WORK COMPLETED DURING MAY 2002

Drafting of text, tables, figures, and appendices for the Work Plan was completed in May. Comments from the PRP Group were incorporated and the Draft RI/FS and IRAM Development Work Plan was submitted to the DEQ on May 13, as agreed during a telephone conference with you on May 8.
