This letter presents the progress made by the PRP Group during June 2002 on RI/FS and IRAM Development at the Astoria Area-Wide Petroleum Site in Astoria, Oregon. This work is being conducted in response to DEQ Order No. ECSR-NWR-01-11 (the Order).

#### **WORK COMPLETED DURING JUNE 2002**

The DEQ provided the PRP Group with comments on the Draft RI/FS and IRAM Development Work Plan in a letter dated June 11, 2002. These comments were addressed through revision of the draft work plan, which began in June.

#### **WORK PLANNED FOR JULY AND AUGUST 2002**

The Final Work Plan is expected to be issued on July 15, 2002, as agreed in our discussion on June 18. Approval of the Final Work Plan by DEQ is expected to occur about August 1. The Work Plan will be implemented within 10 days of approval.

#### **PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED AND RESOLUTIONS**
